



As a former MP, Dr. Sinha continues to contribute in every field through social work. He is also a writer of distinction with publications of 20 books to his credit.

# Our Executive Chairman





The school also carries out periodic health check-ups of the students under the supervision of a visiting doctor. For any emergency the school has its own ambulance.



## **ORGANIC FARMING**

• The Indian Public School is sprawled in 80 acres of land, of which, 30 acres have been converted into an organic farm. Seasonal vegetables and fruits grown here are supplied to the School Dining Hall. These vegetables and fruits are further supplemented by pure milk and milk products from the School Dairy. In addition to this, millet, and grains of this variety also add to the novelty of meals at the school.







### A DAY AT THE INDIAN PUBLIC SCHOOL

At The Indian Public School, students are trained to regulate their daily routine. Life at IPS begins at 5:45am with the rouser bell. All the students are busy till 1:55pm for their Academic Study. After lunch, the second half of the day accommodates sports, supervised prep and dinner at 8:00pm. After dinner, the students have a free window which they can use either for self-study or to catch up with healthy reading habits.
